CLASS 1. YOUNGSTOCK 1, 2 & 3 YEARS OLD. Any breed.

CLASS 2. COB TYPES to include Heavies and Hairies. Any age

CLASS 3. MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND. Small and Large Breeds. Any age.

CLASS 4. COLOURED, Palomino, Roan, Spotted, Dun etc. Any age

CLASS 5. RIDING/HUNTER/ FOREIGN & RARE Breeds. Including part breeds. Horse/pony. Any age

CLASS 6. NOVICE Horse/pony, not to have won more than two 1st in In-hand. Any age

CLASS 7. Veteran Horse/pony. 15 years and over

In hand Championship

1st & 2nd from classes 1 – 7 eligible

Special rosette for Best youngstock and Best Veteran in Classes 2-6

CLASS 16. MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND- Open (Will split if sufficient entries)

CLASS 17. VETERAN - Horse/pony 15 years and over.

CLASS 19. OPEN RIDDEN SHOWING. Including Lead Rein

RULES

1. The committee of Manhood Riding Club will accept no responsibility for any injuries or damage caused to or by any person, horse, or vehicle.
2. The judge's decision is final.
3. Any impolite or aggressive behaviour will result in that person/s being barred from the show with the loss of all their entry fees.
4. All children under 16, showing ponies in-hand must be wearing a correctly fitting riding hat.
5. No Children under 16, should be leading, showing, or riding stallions of any breed or size.
6. Please pick up any litter.
7. **No Dogs to be loose on show ground & no dogs allowed in stable yard or school**
8. Classes will be split or amalgamated on the day if necessary.
9. The secretary/show organiser/judge can refuse entries without giving a reason.
10. No horse/pony under the age of 4 years is to be ridden on the showground.
11. No uninsured drivers are allowed to drive/move vehicles on the show ground.
12. No smoking in or around stables or school
13. **It is a condition of entry to the show that you have public liability insurance for your horse/pony.**
